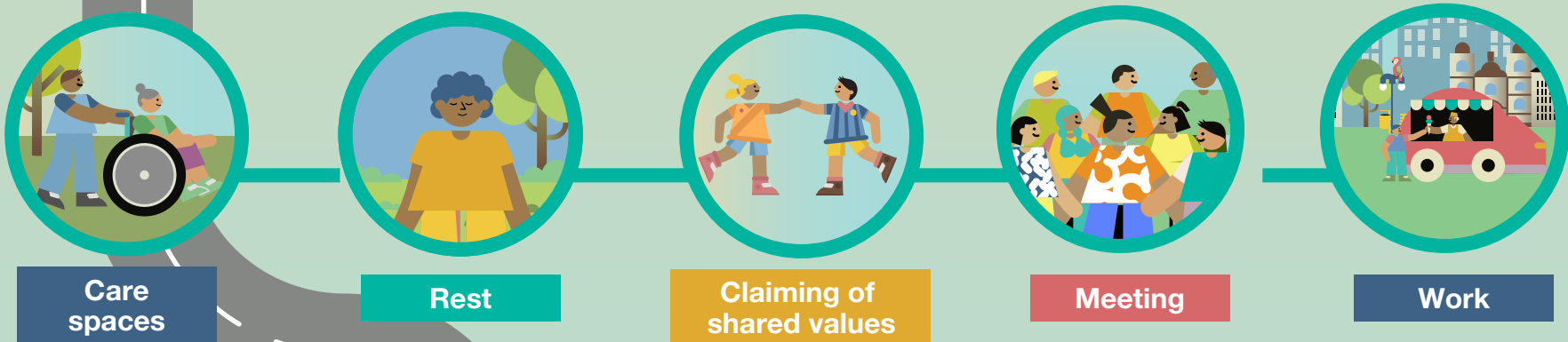


How can we make streets **more accessible, safe, for everyone?**



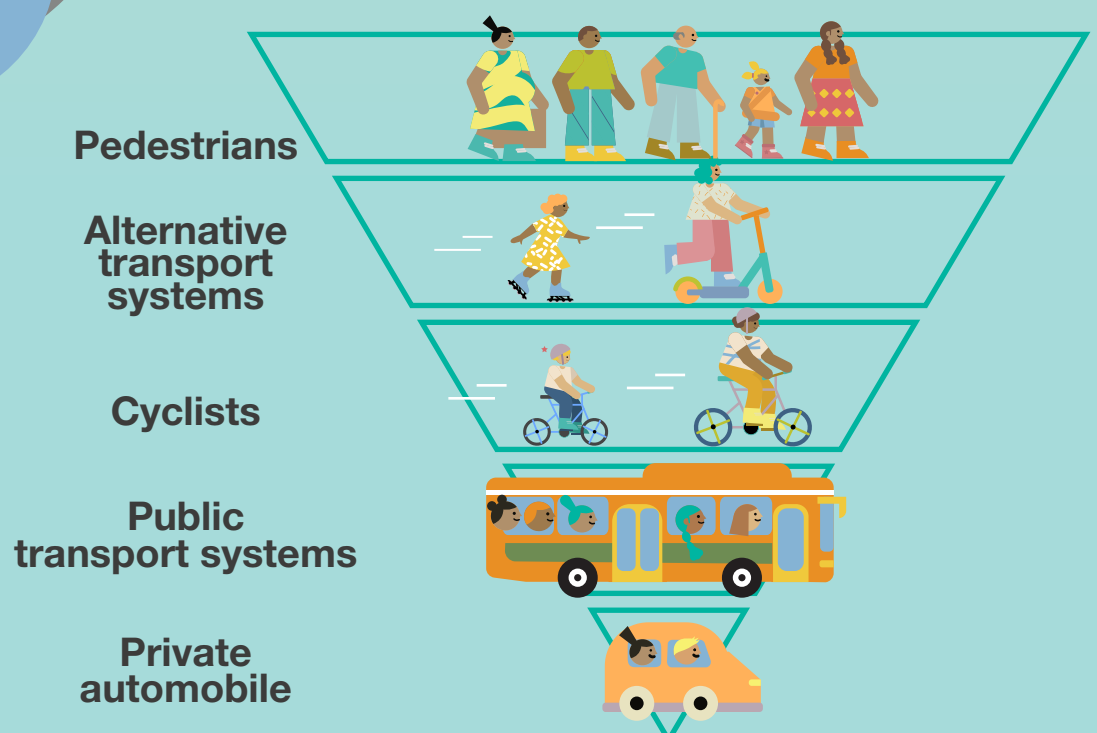
Streets accommodate everyday life:
